Carol A. Daniel is first and foremost, a mother and wife. She and her husband Patrick are celebrating 28 years of marriage. They are also the proud parents of two sons, 27 -year-old Patrick Henry Daniel Jr., a software developer and 23 -year-old Marcus Isaiah Daniel, an actor and chef.

Carol began her career at the "Voice of St. Louis" in 1995 as an anchor, reporter and talk show host. The program director was driving to Memphis, heard Carol on the air at a radio station in Cape Girardeau, Missouri and called her to invite her to apply for a job at the legendary station. She got the job and moved to St. Louis two weeks later to begin her career at KMOX.

Carol is celebrating her 40th year in broadcasting. She has conducted thousands of interviews and earned dozens of honors along the way. The St. Louis Media History Foundation inducted her into the Media Hall of Fame in 2022. In 2021, the Greater St. Louis Association of Black Journalist named her a "Living Legend" and in 2019, the St. Louis Press Club selected her as a Media Person of the year. The National Newspaper Association honored Carol twice in the humor category for her column in the St. Louis American Newspaper. The Missouri Broadcaster's Association, the YWCA Women's Leader Class, STL TV have also recognized her work, and Delux Magazine of St. Louis selected her to their Power 100 list of influential St. Louisans.

Carol served three terms as President of the Greater St. Louis Association of Black Journalist. She is a member of New Life in Christ Interdenominational Church in O'Fallon, Illinois where she and her husband, spearheaded the couple's ministry, "Journey to Oneness" for nearly a decade.

Carol was once a campaign organizer, a recruiter for the U.S. Census Bureau, and even worked as a substitute teacher! Carol is an author and a gifted motivational speaker who believes in the biblical verse, "To whom much is given, much is required."
